Batytychi, Ukraine

Alternate names: Batytychi [Ukr], Batiatycze [Pol], Batytyche, Batjatycki

Region: Lviv Ukraine

Before WWI (c. 1900): Batiatic Zhovkiv galicia Austrian Empire

Between the wars (c. 1930): Batiatic Zhovkiv Lviv Poland

After WWII (c. 1950): Batytychi Soviet Union

Today (c. 2000): Batytychi Ukraine

22 miles NNE of Lviv (Lviv), 13 miles E of Zhovkva (Zhovkva), 4 miles W of Kamyanka Buzka (Kamionka Strumilowa).



Lwów (Lviv / Lemberg) was a city in Poland, until 1945, when it was renamed Lviv and became part of western Ukraine. It was once the capital of the historical region of Galicia. The population of Ukrainian Lviv is current around 729,000.
